





The Sai Mobile Hospital is a unique and free rural outreach holistic health service attached another 6 villages. In practice however, patients are drawn from nearly 400 villages.

The hospital-on-wheels is managed almost entirely on voluntary basis. Five hundred doctors from the state of Andhra Pradesh belonging to 12 specialties serve in rotation.
