Recitation of Omkar, or Pranava (OM), is a daily practice at Prasanthi Nilayam (Bhagavan Sri Sathya Sai Baba's residence in India). It takes place during the early morning hours and is repeated 21 times. Although the number is not arbitrarily fixed, the recitation of OM for each of the twenty components listed above, purifies and clarifies them, with the recitation of the twenty-first OM culminating in preparing the whole person for merger with the the Supreme Absolute (Self-Realization). The Pranava recital concludes with the recitation of 'Santhi' (Peace) three times, for further clarification and purification of the body, mind and spirit. This Pranava recitation will tone you up and calm down the agitations in the mind and quicken the downpour of Grace.

The Pranava (OM) is the original, basic sound from which all other sound emanates. It is the sound of the supreme universal reality called Brahmam. It is the fusion of three primal sounds: A, U, and M. The 'A' represents the 'waking state' (jagrat); the 'U' represents the 'dream state' (swapna); and the 'M' symbolizes the 'deep sleep state' (sushupti). As in the chanting of A-U-M the letters change from A to M but the breath remains constant throughout. Similarly the states of consciousness change from waking to dreaming to deep sleep, but the one self (Atma) is always present. Listen to the primeval Pranava resounding in your heart as well as in the heart of the universe.
